HEALTH DISTRICT OFFERS H1N1 VACCINATION CLINICS FOR SCHOOL AGED CHILDREN AND OTHERS WITHIN THE IDENTIFIED PRIORITY GROUPS

The Central Connecticut Health District will be holding a series of free H1N1 “school based” vaccination clinics for school aged children and others within the identified priority groups. Registration is recommended but not required. Parents who previously submitted a pre-registration form must still call to register. Walk-ins will be accepted as noted below. Upcoming clinics are scheduled as follows:

- **Newington-** Saturday, December 12, 2009 at the Newington Senior and Disabled Center, 120 Cedar Street, Newington from 9 AM to 2 PM. (walk-ins accepted after 12 noon as time permits)
- **Rocky Hill-** Tuesday, December 15, 2009 at Griswold Middle School, 144 Bailey Road, Rocky Hill, CT from 4 PM to 7 PM. (walk-ins accepted after 5:30 PM as time permits)
- **Berlin-** Thursday, December 17, 2009 at Willard Elementary School, 1088 Norton Road, Berlin, CT from 4 PM to 7 PM. (walk-ins accepted after 5:30 PM as time permits)
- **Wethersfield-** date, time location TBD. Please check web site.

Individuals MUST be within one of the following priority groups to be vaccinated:

Pregnant women
Household contacts and caregivers of infants less than 6 months of age
Anyone aged 6 months through 24 years
Individuals aged 25 through 64 years with high risk chronic medical conditions
Health care personnel

All students and others who fall into any of the above targeted priority groups who would like to receive the H1N1 vaccination may register by calling (860)721-2815. Registration is by telephone only and all requested information must be provided. Registration will be confirmed via a recorded telephone message.

Participants are asked to download and complete the appropriate vaccination form (either nasal spray or injection) from the Health District’s website: www.ccthd.org. Forms will also be available at the clinic. Please note that the nasal spray is recommended for healthy individuals age 2-49. Nasal spray CANNOT be given to people with a chronic medical condition or pregnant women.
